3. To recognize and use school words	Vocabulary: bag, book, chair, classroom crayon, desk, pen, pencil, pencil case, eraser, teacher What 's this? This is a crayon This is a pencil
4. To ask and say where things are	Prepositions of place in, next to, on, under Where is the book? It 's on the table The pencil is next to the eraser
5. To recognize the body parts vocabulary	Body parts: arm, body, ear, eye, face, feet, foot, hair, hand, head, leg, mouth, nose,
6. To talk about families and relationships	Family vocabulary: brother, dad, father, grandfather, grandma, grandmother, grandpa, mother, mom, sister, brother twins, family, This is my mother.

<p>8. To use There is/isn't/are /aren't accurately to describe where objects are</p>	<p>Answer questions Are there...? / Is there...?, There is/are/ isn't/aren't... classroom words</p>
<p>9. To describe actions happening at the moment of speaking</p>	<p>Present progressive tense: sentences and questions Verbs such as: cleaning, eating, painting, singing, sleeping, walking, jumping, reading What are you doing? What is he/she doing? I am...-ing – You/We/They are...ing He/she is ... ing Are you/we/they ...ing? Is he/she...-ing? Yes, they are. / Yes, he/she is. Words and phrases describing sports and activities</p>
<p>10. To understand the use of "Can" to talk about abilities</p>	<p>Affirmative – negative sentences I can play - She can't swim Answer questions Can you...? / Can they...? Can you dance? Dance, play, swim, eat, read, run, study, drink, play, paint, work</p>
