To ask and answer questions about what people are doing	<i>Use the Present Progressive to answer questions or complete sentences</i> <i>Are you reading a book? No, I'm not. I'm doing my homework.</i> <i>Is she playing tennis? Yes, she is. She's playing tennis.</i> <i>Are they putting on their boots? No, they aren't, They're taking off their boots,</i> <i>What are they doing? They are eating</i> <i>Verbs</i> <i>Drink, play, walk, read, eat, swim, work, jump, play, write, sit, study, wash</i>
To use simple present for routines with times (o'clock)	<i>Use the simple present to answer questions or say sentences</i> <i>What time do you get up? I get up at seven o'clock.</i> <i>What time does school finish? It finishes at four o'clock,</i> <i>finish, go home, go to bed</i> <i>Daily routines at school: do homework, go to school, have lunch, class, start lessons,</i>

To say the days of the week	<i>Days of the week</i> <i>Monday, Tuesday,</i> <i>Wednesday,</i> <i>Thursday, Friday,</i> <i>Saturday, Sunday</i>
To use simple present and present progressive appropriately	<u>Simple present (simple verb / verb + S)</u> <u>Present Progressive (am-is -are + verb -ing)</u> <i>Drink, walk, read, play, eat, swim,</i> <i>work, jump, paint, write, sit,</i> <i>study, wash</i> <i>Sentences: She is drinking water.</i> <i>Questions</i> <i>What's he doing?</i> <i>He is reading a book</i>
To use prepositions	Prepositions, in on, under, next to above, below, close to, across from Sentences: The cat is under the table. Questions: Where is the book? It's on the desk
To talk about the weather	<i>The weather vocabulary</i> <i>Cloud, cloudy, cold, hot, make a video call, rain</i> <i>sunny, wind, windy, terrible, weather, put on,</i> <i>What's the weather like? It's sunny / rainy...</i>
<i>To talk about food</i> <i>To describe likes and dislikes</i>	<i>Bottle, bowl, cheese, cooking, cup, glass,</i> <i>pasta, plate, salad, sandwich, soup,</i> <i>vegetables,</i> <i>I like to eat cheese. I don't like to eat pasta</i>
<i>To use adjectives to talk about opinions and feelings</i>	Adjectives <i>Afraid, boring, dangerous, difficult, easy,</i> <i>exciting, scared, hungry, surprised, thirsty,</i> <i>tired,</i> <i>How do you feel? I feel thirsty.</i> <i>The boy is afraid of dogs.</i>
