<p>To present and identify food.</p> <p>To talk about likes and dislikes.</p>	<p>sausages, apples, cakes, ice cream, fries, dinner, tonight, carrots, chicken, fish, water, orange juice</p> <p>I like (apples), I don't like (fish).</p>
<p>To present and identify clothes.</p>	<p>Hat, belt, boots, shirt, pants, button, skirt, dress, sweater, jacket.</p> <p>I'm wearing</p> <p>I like wearing pants.</p> <p>I like, your, (purple) (shirt), shoes.</p>
